## **Category Juniors**

#### **JUNIOR Men and Ladies**

Free Skating:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2010, Rule 512 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the elements value.

Duration:

Men: 4 min, +/- 10 sec

Ladies: 3 min, 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

Factors:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010, Rule 353, paragraph 1, m) the multiplying factors for the Program Components are: for Men Short Program 1,0 Free Skating 2,0 for Ladies Short Program 0,8 Free Skating 1,6

## **Category Advanced Novices Girls and Boys**

#### **ADVANCED NOVICE Girls and Boys**

Free Skating:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in the ISU Communication No. 1649 Duration: 3:00 min, +/. 10 sec for girls

3:30 min, +/- 10 sec for boys

## **Category Debs Girls and Boys**

**Age requirements**: Everybody who has not reached the age of 13 before July 1<sup>st</sup> 2011

**Free Program**: Duration: Girls: 3 min +/- 10 sec Boys: 3 min +/- 10 sec

- max. 6 Jump elements (1 Axeltype), witch may contain max. 2 jump combinations or sequences, of wich max. 1 jump-combination of 3 jumps.

- Repetition of jumps: single, double and triple jumps A, S, F, Lz can be repeated a maximum of two times and if repeated they must be in combination

- 1 combination spin with or without change of foot

- 1 Flying spin (no change of foot and no change of position)

- 1 step sequence of free choice

- one choreo spiral (base value 1 point, max level 3)

### FALL DEDUCTION : 0,5

**BONUS JUMPS**: Every jump identified as 2A, and all other jumps with higher basic value, will receive a bonus of one point. In order to receive a bonus the jump must NOT be downgraded and must not have an asterisk. The bonus is assigned by the specialist and confirmed by controller and is added to the technical element score.

## **Category Springs Girls and Boys (A and B)**

**Age requirements**: Everybody who has not reached the age of 12 before July 1<sup>st</sup> 2011

Free Program: Duration: Girls: 3 min +/- 10 sec

Boys: 3 min +/- 10 sec

- max. 6 Jump elements (1 Axel type), which may contain max. 2 jump combinations or sequences, of wich max. 1 jump-combination of 3 jumps.

- Repetition of jumps: single, double and triple jumps A, S, F, Lz can be repeated a maximum of two times and if repeated they must be in combination.

1 spin with only 1 position (with or without change of foot or flying entrance)

- 1 combination spin with or without change of foot (no flying entrance)

- 1 step sequence of free choice

- one choreo spiral (base value 1 point, max level 3)

#### FALL DEDUCTION : 0.5

**BONUS JUMPS**: Every jump identified as 2A, and all other jumps with higher basic value, will receive 1 bonus of one point. In order to receive a bonus the jump must NOT be downgraded and must not have an asterisk. The bonus is assigned by the specialist and confirmed by controller and is added to the technical element score.

**BONUS JUMP COMBINATIONS**: any combination of two or more than two double ore more difficult jumps will receive bonus of 0,5 point. In order to receive the bonus all jumps in the combination must be valid (no downgraded or under rotated or asterisk or "e"). The bonus is assigned by the specialist and confirmed by controller and is added to the technical element score. All double jumps well executed (must Not be downgraded or under rotated and must not have an asterisk), except double Axel, will receive a bonus of one point.

## Category Cubs Girls and Boys (A and B)

**Age requirements**: Everybody who has not reached the age of 10 before July 1<sup>st</sup> 2011

Free Program: Duration: Girls and boys: 2 min 30 +/- 10

- max. 6 Jump elements (1 Axel type or Waltz Jump), which may contain max. 2 jump combinations or sequences, of wich max. 1 jump-combination of 3 jumps.
- Repetition of jumps: single, double and triple jumps A, S, F, Lz can be repeated a maximum of two times and if repeated they must be in combination.
- 1 spin with only 1 position with or without change of foot
- 1 spin different from the first one (change of foot is possible)
- 1 choreo step sequence (mx level 3)

#### FALL DEDUCTION : 0,5

**BONUS JUMPS**: All double jumps well executed (must Not be downgraded or under rotated and must not have an asterisk), except double Axel, will receive a bonus of one point.

The bonus is assigned by the specialist and confirmed by controller and is added to the technical element score.

**BONUS JUMP COMBINATIONS**: any combination of two or more than two double ore more difficult jumps will receive a bonus of one point. In order to receive the bonus all jumps in the combination must be valid (no downgraded or under rotated or asterisk). The bonus is assigned by the specialist and confirmed by controller and is added to the technical element score.

LEVELS: only level one and two are possible in this category

Accreditation will be given to all Competitors, Judges, Coaches and Chaperons.

#### **Results**

The calculation of results will be done according to ISU Technical Rules

#### **Awards**

The first three best placed competitors in each event will be awarded by cups; all competitors will be awarded by medals.

The best Athlete of the Competition will be awarded by the Friendshipcup.

The best Committee will be awarded by the Friendship- Committee - cup.

The first three placed competitors "ice factor" of the categories cups, debs and springs are awarded.

# PROJECT "ICE FACTOR"

Awarding young talents
For the categories Cubs and Springs

The project *Ice Factor* was born from the idea to include a contest amongst the competition. It is so a second important presentation of awards at this international event Friendshipcup "E.Köcher" in Merano from October  $30^{th}$  to November  $1^{st}$ .

This special award will not be given to the athletes with the highest technical abilities or to the performance with the highest level but to the talents with that certain something, the little bit more, an X factor of the ice-skating.

It is an assessment which doesn't solely follow the criteria of the new ISU Constitution and General Regulations. Furthermore it is a subjective observation and perception which is influenced by everybody's own taste.

The jury will consist of various artists, each an expert in a different field.

The jury will be only told about the general regulations they have to follow in the assessment; otherwise they are free of any other rules. They have got complete freedom in their decision which will be influenced by emotion and personal feelings and not mainly by rational sense of criticism.

The guidelines for the judgements are the following:

- Originality, Creativity
- Particular technical, interpreting and communicative abilities.
- Distinctive musicality and conscious effort to use the music for the choreography.
- Potential for a positive future development.
- Lightheartedness and elegance in performing the elements.
- Ability to convey emotions, fun and passion for the ice-skating.
- X-factor: the inexplicable "a bit more" than the others

The jury is not definitely arranged but will mainly consist of artists and experts:

- Ice Skaters
- Choreographs
- Dancers
- Actors
- Marketing and Communication Experts

 3<sup>rd</sup> place Cubs Girls: Voucher for a tracksuit

2<sup>nd</sup> place Springs Girls: Voucher for a competition dress

3<sup>rd</sup> place Springs Girls: Voucher for a tracksuit

1<sup>st</sup> place Boys from 8 to 12 years: Skates with blades

2<sup>nd</sup> place Boys from 8 to 12 years: Voucher for a competition dress

3<sup>rd</sup> place Boys from 8 to 12 years: Voucher for a tracksuit

Best placed South-Tyrolean athlete: Voucher for a tracksuit
